Digital Commons vs. SelectedWorks

- Digital Commons: the institutional record listed by academic department
 - Librarian adds material to DC depts.
 - Librarian “collects” material into individual SW sites
- SelectedWorks: Your site to showcase your own professional record
 - Dynamic; the collected articles, etc. are the base.
The rest is up to you

Teaching Tool

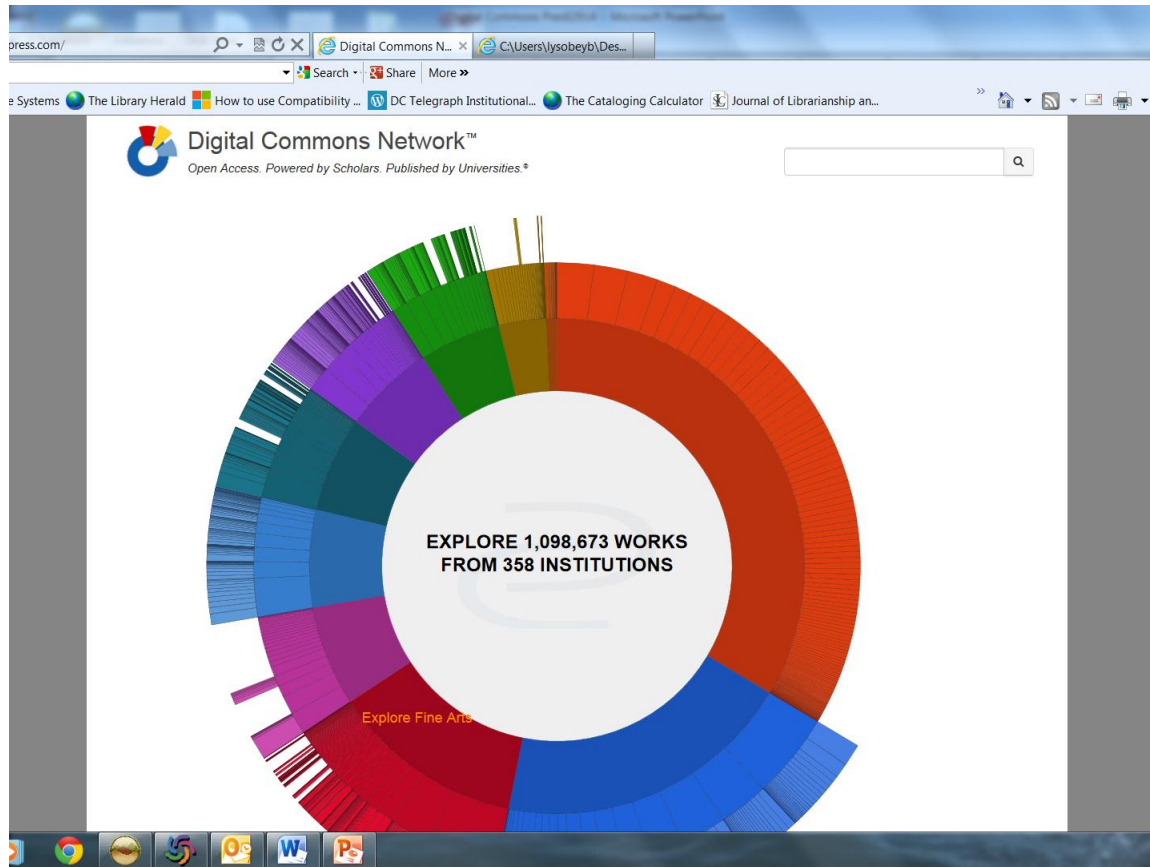
- Can SelectedWorks be useful in teaching?
