Dear members of the Sacred Heart University community,

We have received some questions about whether SHU **students can get vaccinated in Connecticut** even if they live in another state. The answer is yes. You can use your SHU address (if you live on campus, use 5151 Park Ave., Fairfield 06825). We recommend that you plan it in such a way that your second dose (if you do not get a Johnson & Johnson vaccine) can also be done in Connecticut. Connecticut has [a portal where you can register for vaccination](#). Depending on where you choose to be vaccinated, you may be directed to another registration site.

Please remember to upload your vaccination information to your student portal once you have received the necessary doses. How much of the SHU community has been vaccinated is one of the factors we are considering as we make decisions about lifting some of the COVID restrictions.

### **Please Answer the Phone if the Area Code is 720 or 949**

It is important that **everyone answers their phone** if you see an area code of 720 or 949. These calls are from our contact tracers. The outstanding work they are doing has been instrumental in keeping the virus from spreading around campus. We appreciate your cooperation.
