Coronavirus Update 2-3-22

Dear members of the Sacred Heart University community,

There will be two booster clinics on campus this weekend that will be open to students, faculty and staff and their family members.

Saturday's clinic will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the Edgerton Center atrium. There will be 200 doses available. This is a Hartford HealthCare clinic, and appointments are required. You can make an appointment to receive either the [Pfizer third dose](#) or the [Moderna third dose](#).

Sunday's clinic will be from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Edgerton Center atrium. Griffin Hospital will be sponsoring this walk-in clinic. No appointments are necessary.

Identification and vaccination cards will be required for both clinics.

Blood Drives

We have had a tremendous response to our upcoming blood drives. It is wonderful to see the SHU community stepping up to help with the severe national and local blood shortage resulting from COVID. Thank you to all who have signed up and to the student captains who are recruiting donors. This drive is being held in conjunction with the Connecticut Blood Bank and Hartford HealthCare/St. Vincent's Hospital.

Blood drives will take place on Wednesdays, February 16, February 23 and March 2 from 10:30 a.m. to 7 p.m., in the Edgerton Center atrium. You can [make an appointment to donate online](#). **Use the SHU Code C008** to get to the SHU drives. You will see the word "closed" on each of the drives. That does not mean the drive is full; it means that it is not open to the general public—only to members of the SHU community. You can click on the word "schedule" to make your appointment. That said, the two February drives are already full and the March drive is filling quickly. We will be scheduling future drives and are creating a waiting list for those who want to donate once those dates are set.
