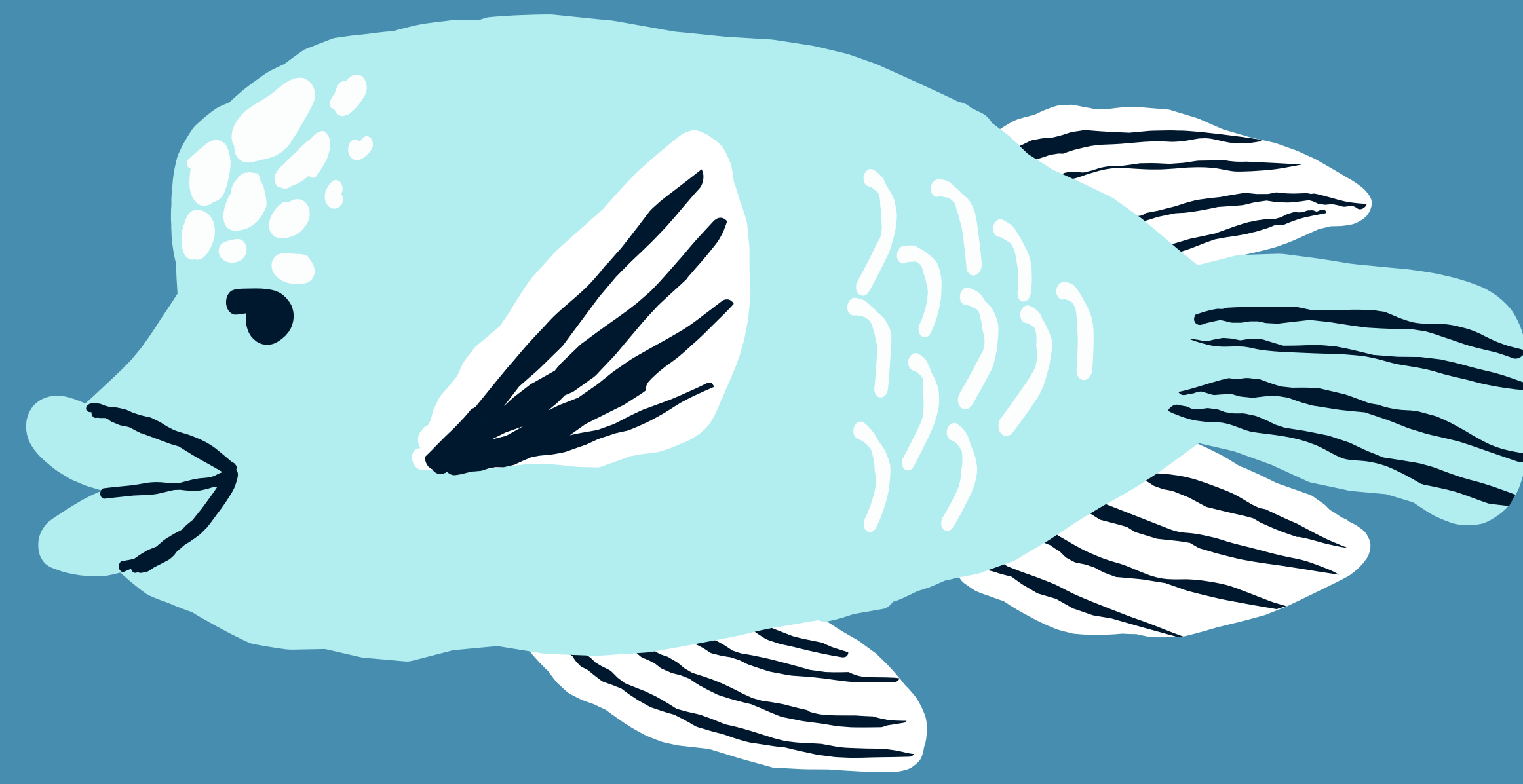


Want fish to have a future?

"Why should we care?"

Over 90%

Of the world's trade occurs by ocean transport.

71%

71 percent of our world inhabits marine life. That means only 29 percent of our world is made of land instead of water.

"How does this affect us?"

When marine animals ingest plastic, the fish we eat are then contaminated, polluting our own bodies with plastic, waste, and pesticides.

That means more than 3 billion people rely on the ocean for their livelihoods. The ocean gives us at least half of the oxygen to breathe and regulates our climate.
