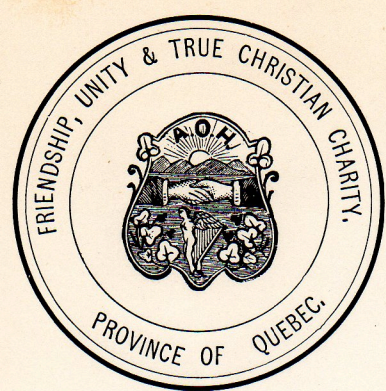

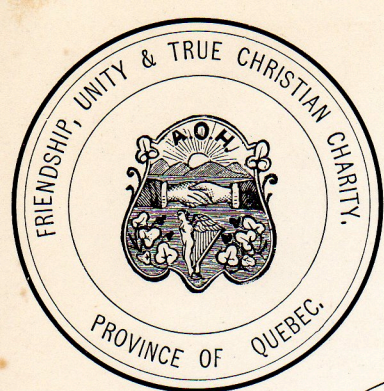

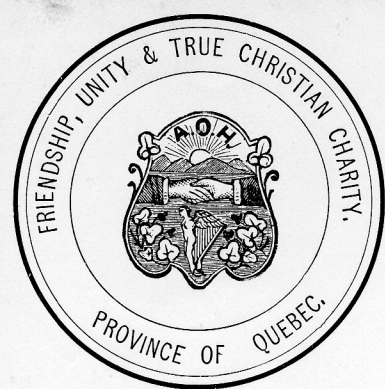
Dear Sir & Bro.

Dear Sir and Bro.

I enclose you cheque for \$198.50 accompanied by Annual report for yr. ending 31 Dec. 1903. I may appear to be blamable for delay but you cant always command us just as you would desire

Now I'm most surprised at the account you sent me whenever you had got that N^o. 1110 you will be bound to assess on it. I refer you to my statement of 4th. April 1903 for true state of our affairs. Coffey no doubt deceived you - made you false statements as he has done with us. The contemptible house never handed us over minute book, papers or a cash statement & appears to say that we have persecuted him. We have not recovered from the shock of his miserable conduct yet. We have gone into the standing with the C^o of Montreal (~~Hochelaga~~), the main one. The officers there are splendid fellows and after honest & patient inquiry the Numerical Standing I sent for 31 Dec. 92 showed the true standing on 31 Dec. 1901. namely 743 for the former & 768 for the latter. I can understand that Coffey might have made a wilful error to appear keep up the strength as in 1900. though I do not know what to think when

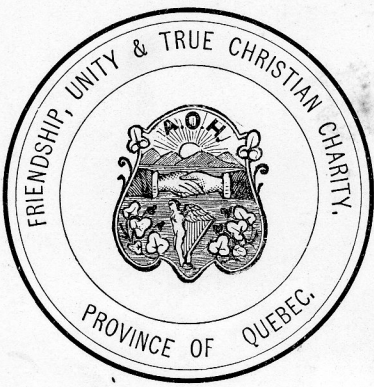
