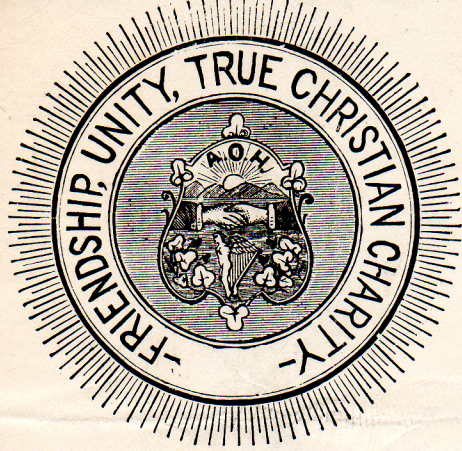

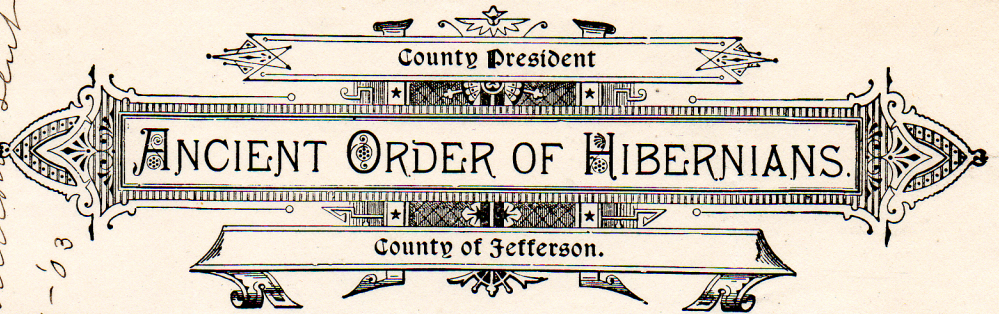

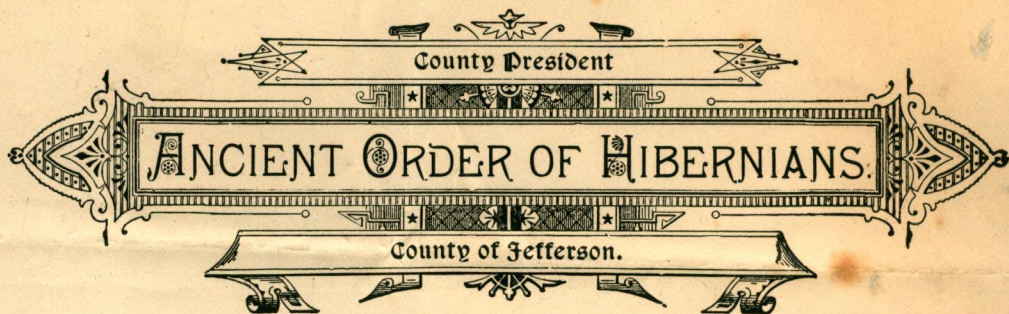

I thought I would write you and tell you what Jefferson Co is doing we are on the boom all the divisions except Div No 1 which is on a stand still

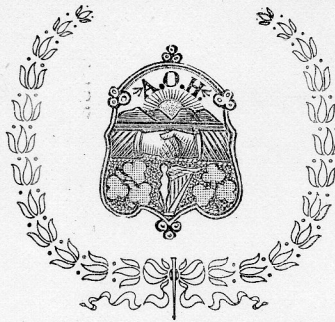
I had the pleasure to meet Bro D E Ryan National organizer and he left a lasting impression on all who had the pleasure to hear him

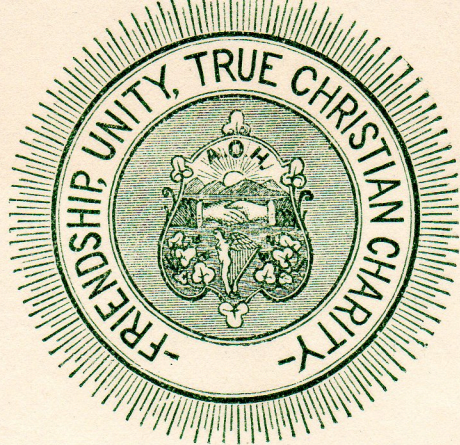
