STATE OF CONNECTICUT.

Paymaster-General's Office,

New Haven, September, 1862.

DEAR SIR:—

I have to request that you will give explicit orders to the officers of each company to comply with the following regulations.

1st. That some one officer of each company be designated to witness the orders for State payment, and keep a register of them, that there may be no duplicates.

2d. All orders must be on blanks furnished by this department, and none issued till after the payment is due.

It is necessary that the correct number of payment be inserted in the order. The second payment is due 4 months from date of muster; third payment, 8 months; fourth payment, 12 months; &c.

Much inconvenience will be saved if the orders are made payable to the parties to whom they are sent.

Blanks will be furnished upon requisition of the Adjutant.
